

**PUBLIC COMPUTERS USE POLICY
(7/15/2008)**

Individuals using Louisiana State University's computing resources are expected to do so in an appropriate, ethical, and lawful manner that demonstrates respect for the rights of other users and recognizes the importance of civility and responsibility. All computer use must be in accordance with University PS-107: Use of Computing Resources. Misuse of library computers may result in the suspension or loss of privilege to use them.

The LSU Libraries endorse the Library Bill of Rights and the Freedom to Read statement of the American Library Association. We do not monitor or filter information accessed through the public workstations and cannot be held liable for the content or quality of information accessed. As with other library materials, any restriction of a minor's access to and use of the Internet is the responsibility of the parent or legal guardian.

Policies for Computer Usage:

- 1) Computers are available on a first come, first served basis.
- 2) Computers are assigned by "tickets" issued at the Reference desk. These tickets contain a unique ID which will allow the user up to sixty minutes of computer time upon logon.
- 3) Patrons must be at least sixteen years of age or accompanied by an adult for computer access.
- 4) Reference staff reserve the right to request a photo ID (either government or school issued) for access to the computers.
- 5) There can be no more than two people at each computer.
- 6) No waiting list will be kept once computers are occupied.
