PubWEST: Available only through PTDLs, this is the same search interface Patent Examiners are using to research Prior Art. It combines the databases of patents and patent applications into one search.

CASSIS: This computer system was developed by the USPTO for patent and trademark research. One of its unique advantages is the ability users have to download large amounts of information into Excel Spreadsheets.
