#### BIOGRAPHICAL/HISTORICAL NOTE

Joseph G. Richard was an author, teacher and director of the Louisiana Agricultural Extension Service at Louisiana State University in Baton Rouge, Louisiana. He taught vocational agriculture at Gilbert, Franklin Parish, Louisiana from 1923 until 1925. In 1926, he accepted the position of county agent in Terrebonne Parish, a post he held until 1935. Richard also worked as an agricultural specialist in extension methods and agricultural experimental station research in France for the European Office of the Mutual Security Agency, 1953, and as an agricultural consultant of the Food and Agricultural Organization of the United Nations in Switzerland, Austria, Italy and Africa, 1962. In addition, he served as a technical advisor to visiting agriculturist from the United Arab Republic, 1966, and as an advisor to the Brazilian Sugar Team visiting the United States, 1970.

#### SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The collection reflects the long and distinguished career of Joseph G. Richard as a leader in field of agriculture. Papers also reflect his interest in Louisiana native irises and his work in the cultivation of irises. The collection includes material relative to the Mary Swords DeBaillon Iris Society, as well as and printed items on irises.

Papers are comprised of correspondence, teaching materials, printed items, speeches, writings, and photographs of extension work in rural Louisiana during 1930s. Printed items contain several circulars and bulletins produced by the LSU Agricultural Extension (1915-1938). The collection also includes county agents' and agricultural extension workers' diaries (1918-1950), and memorandum books (1918-1950). Also found is a corn shucker (undated) such as the type used in France.
