Claude L. Shaver was a member of the faculty in the Department of Speech at Louisiana State University (LSU) in Baton Rouge, Louisiana.

Box 1:

Materials related to the Southwest Theatre 21st Annual Conference (SWTC) include correspondence inviting speakers and suggesting programs and workshops, registration forms, LSU campus maps, and financial papers related to the conferences (1968). There are also programs for plays produced by the LSU Speech Department.

Box 2:

In addition to correspondence, there are student summer theater programs for years 1969 to 1973 and files for summer festivals (1958, 1964-1972). Also included is a draft of the play *These Are My People, This Is My Land*. Other files include records for the Louisiana Council for Music and Performing Arts (LCMPA) contest on plays written by students (1971).

Box 3:

Found in the files is correspondence with individuals at the University of Alaska, at several other universities, at the Speech Association of America (SAA), and at the American National Theater and Academy (ANTA).

Box 4:

Files contain information and correspondence on the ANTA, issues of *Louisiana Speaks*, and materials from a speech conference in honor of C. M. Wise. There are also several booklets, programs, and playbills for theater productions.

Box 5:
