BIOGRAPHICAL/HISTORICAL NOTE

James Coleman Prewitt was born October 17, 1927, in Jacksonville, Florida, the only child of George Coleman Prewitt (1895-1981) and Florrie Gornto Prewitt (1893-1976). In 1928 his family moved to New Orleans, Louisiana, where he grew up. Prewitt graduated from Louisiana State University (LSU) in 1948. While at LSU, he co-founded the student literary magazine *Delta*, for which he served as Associate Editor. After graduating from LSU, Prewitt lived in New York City for a brief period before returning to New Orleans. In 1957 he began teaching in the public school system of Louisiana where he remained until his retirement in 1977. Prewitt was a prolific writer, though he rarely published his work. Throughout his life he completed five novels, two novellas, six short story collections, as well as several poems, essays, and other writings. He also actively journaled, often taking notes that he used in his writing. Prewitt died October 26, 1989, in Gulfport, Mississippi, at age 62.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The James Coleman Prewitt Papers contain the personal papers and the writings of Prewitt. The papers are arranged into four series: Correspondence, Personal Papers, Writings, and Volumes. The Correspondence, Personal Papers, and Volumes series are all arranged chronologically. The Writings series is arranged alphabetically by title. The papers also contain notes left by East that provide additional information, description, and context for most of the items. These notes have been kept with the items to which they refer.

Series I. Correspondence, 1938-1989, undated

This series contains correspondence from 1938 to 1989. Included in this series is correspondence between Prewitt and his mother, Florrie Prewitt (box 1, folders 1-38 and box 2, folders 1-12), as well as correspondence between Prewitt and his close friend, Charles East (box 2, folders 13-19). This series also includes correspondence between Prewitt and various literary agents and editors (box 2, folders 20-21). This series is arranged chronologically.

Series II. Personal Papers, 1930-1976, undated

This series contains personal papers from 1930 to 1976. Included in this series are photographs of Prewitt (box 2, folders 24-25), issues from the LSU student literary magazine Delta for which Prewitt served as Associate Editor (box 2, folder 29), Prewitt's review of Truman Capote's Other Voices, Other Rooms (box 2, folder 31), and other personal papers. This series is arranged chronologically.

Series III. Writings, 1947-1989, undated

This series contains writings from 1947 to 1989. Included in this series are completed typescripts and drafts of Prewitt's novels, short stories, essays, poems, and other writings. This series includes typescripts and drafts of Prewitt's novels City of Orgies (box 2, folders 33-45 and box 3, folders 1-22), Difference and Decay (box 4, folders 2-5), The Hour of the Knife (box 4, folders 9-13), Prisoner's Rest (box 4, folders 27-41), and The Sleep of the Dead (box 5, folders 18-24). Also included in this series are typescripts and drafts of Prewitt's short story collections Communion of Saints (box 3, folders 28-38), A Portfolio for Charles East (box 4, folders 22-26), The Short Stories of James Coleman Prewitt (box 5, folders 1-17), Stories from the Quarter (box 5, folders 25-33), Teacher's Lounge (box 5, folders 34-44), and A Vision of Judgment (box 5, folders 45-53). This series also includes Prewitt's Collected Poems (box 3, folders 23-27) and the essay compilations Facing Oblivion (box 4, folders 6-8) and The Remains of James Coleman Prewitt (box 4, folders 42-57). Although most of Prewitt's writings were not published, all titles included in this series are final versions unless otherwise labeled as drafts. This series is arranged alphabetically by title.

Series IV. Volumes, 1939-1989, undated

This series contains volumes from 1939 to 1989. Included in this series are journals that Prewitt kept throughout his life. Volumes 1 through 8 include his early writings from 1939 to 1944, volumes 9 through 16 include fiction writing from 1945 to 1947, and volumes 17 through 47 are Prewitt's personal journals from 1947 to 1989. This series is arranged chronologically.
